Job Description for EQUIP Program Teacher

- Job Title – EQUIP Program Teacher
- Job Summary – Jungle Kids for Christ (JKC) is a growing ministry whose goal is to empower children of the Ecuadorian jungle by sharing the gospel through education and teaching values and leadership. In addition to other ministries, JKC runs a growing school named Antioch Christian Academy. This is a teaching position at that school. The EQUIP Program Teacher position is an initiative that tries to attract qualified English and other subject teachers and differs from the regular teaching position in that JKC offers additional perks such as room and board with amenities, round trip plane ticket once per year, VISA, Health Insurance while overseas, and a salary (based on overseas pay).
- Commitment length – 2 full school years plus 6 months of Spanish language training before teaching (if needed).
- Responsibilities and Duties
 - Guarantee an adequate environment in the classroom prioritizing the harmony between students and teacher.
 - Conduct daily devotionals every morning before starting classes, cultivating in the students an intimate relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ.
 - Have full knowledge of the code of conduct and the different regulations and directives implemented by the General Director or immediate supervisor.
 - Plan your classes properly and make planning updates when applicable.
 - Ask for all didactic/pedagogical material to carry out its planning in a timely manner.
 - Follow established disciplinary procedures and inform the Inspector general when an event of a disciplinary nature occurs.

- Track sensitive behavioral cases and report to the counseling department (DECE) when required.
 - Actively participate in preventive health or environmental campaigns programmed by the General Director.
 - Reviewing the “Leccionario” (Daily grade registrar) making sure you are aware of concerns or recommendations expressed by parents.
 - Perform regular and corrective workbooks reviews by paying special attention to spelling, regardless of the subject.
 - Correct and provide feedback regularly to students.
 - Present end of the unit and end of the semester evaluations to Academic Director in a timely manner for review.
 - Use the established disciplinary tools and/or techniques to achieve a harmonious behavior of the group in classes.
 - Ensure equitable participation of all students in the development of the class.
 - Integrate with students during lunch time and recess to strengthen relationship.
 - Supervise the assigned recreation areas.
 - Maintain the order and hygiene of your classroom by engaging students in appropriate activities.
 - Assistance and coordination in events such as: Sports championship (opening/closing/Family Day), year-end trips, Christmas and community visits and all events included in the annual calendar.
- Possible additional responsibilities
 - Transportation assistant
 - Grade supervisor
- Qualifications and Requirements
 - Available to travel to Quito-Ecuador for language training for 6 months. Preferably from January to July.
 - Commit yourself to serve for at least 2 years teaching in the jungle.
 - Provide proof of a degree (Bachelor’s or higher), or need to provide proof of a minimum of 3 years of teaching experience
 - Agree with our statement of faith and abide by the code of conduct

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
